Membership

- Each member will invite at least one potential member to come to a meeting.
- Each club will have a plan for Orientation and Retention of members.

Foundation

- Each club will give to the Rotary Foundation. Every Rotarian Every Year is encouraged.
- Each club will take part in the “End Polio Now” campaign by setting a goal then having a plan to obtain the goal.
- Increase of number of Grants submitted by clubs. I would like to see 50% of our clubs apply for a grant.

Service

- Each club will complete a project in the area of Literacy.
- Each club will complete a project in the area of Health/hunger.
- Each club will participate in a Water project by partnering with another club or completing one on their own.
- Each club will emphasize the “lost avenue of service” according to President Elect John Kenny. Vocational Service is that avenue. Vocational Service encourages Rotarians to serve others through their vocations and to practice high ethical standards. A program on *Ethics in the Workplace* or related topic is expected.

Youth

- Each club will have a Youth Exchange Program
- Each club will participate in Rotary Youth Leadership Awards by sending a student or adult volunteer or have a past RYLA student give a Program.
- Each club will be aware and fully involved in the District Youth Compliance Certificate program.

Training

- Each club will submit to the District Governor, at least one person in their club that is a potential District Leader.
- Each club will send the President Elect to the 2010-11 Mid America PETS in Fort Smith.
- Each Secretary or a club representative will attend the Secretary Elect Training.
- The Rotary Leadership Institute is in a study phase for this year. If possible we will have participation in the Heart of America Rotary Leadership Institute.

Public Image

- Each club will have a Public Relations Chair.
- Each club will keep their local news media informed of their activities.
- Each club will submit an article for the District Newsletter during your assigned month. Your Assistant Governor will know your month.

Club Goal

- Individualize in your club our theme. *“The Future of Rotary is in Your Hands.”* Each club President will be asked to put in writing how your club accomplished this at the end of the year reporting.
